Activities carried out

I. New partner schools

In July 2022, two more new schools have come on board and partnered with PPI and they include Kyaliwajjala UMEA primary school and Uganda Martyrs Boys primary school thus making a total number of 10 partner schools reached with our program.

This Bible camp was a success and a great milestone that hosted 103 girls from various partner and non-partner schools. Girls had bible lessons by Pr. Amie from Faith Baptist Church on Faith and Resilience. There was sexual reproductive health and rights

Girls had breakfast and lunch with PPI team

They enjoyed a good day with games like sack-peeling-competitions, music dance competitions, balloon chase games and all these aimed at creating an ample time with the girls and offer solutions to some of their expectations and challenges.

- Paid tuition fees to 10 girls for a term


Challenges faced in term two
